Dear Sir,

I have to inform you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Owners of the steamer "BALTABOR", which vessel has been ashore on Nargen Island in the Baltic since last December and which it is understood has now been refloated and is to be placed in dry dock at Reval, requesting Mr. J. S. Butler, one of the Senior Ship Surveyors on the Outdoor Staff here, to proceed to Reval in company with their representative to make a survey on their behalf of the damage sustained to the vessel with a view to making the necessary recommendations for repairs required to restore her class.

The Committee have acceded to this request, and I thought it well to advise you of the facts and to enclose herewith a copy of the letter I have to-day addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Tallinn on the subject.
