Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant respecting the S.S. "BALTABOR" and to inform you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel before them at their meeting today, and I am directed to inform you that, after consideration of the circumstances they feel that, consistently with the course followed in similar instances, a record of the stranding of the vessel should be made against her name in the Register Book as described in my letter of the 7th instant.

I may add, however, that in the event of the vessel being refloated and repaired to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the notation of casualty will be withdrawn immediately upon reclassification by this Society.
