Gentlemen,

S. I am in receipt of your letter of the 4th instant and your first entry reports on the new steamer "LIBAU", and in compliance with your request I enclose herewith the first entry certificates on the hull and machinery of this vessel for delivery in the usual way.

At the same time I have to say that in view of your last survey of the vessel having been so long ago as the 27th ultimo it is to be regretted that in view of the urgency of the matter your reports were not ready to be forwarded on that date when the certificates could have been in the possession of the Owners much earlier.

I have to add that the Owners state that the sister vessel "ST. PETERSBURG", is expected to be delivered to them by the 1st June, and as they wish in her case also to have the classification certificates delivered before she sails in order to avoid delay and inconvenience in connexion with the requirements of the Russian Authorities, I have to request that you will prepare your reports in good time and forward them to this Office on
