H. With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No.2 which became due so long ago as October, 1931 on the steamer "SOENGED GERONG", I have to acquaint you that I am informed by the Owners that this vessel has been sold to Shanghai to be broken up, and the Committee have agreed to her proceeding with a cargo of white products from Palembang to Hong Kong thence to Shanghai.

It is understood that she will not be sailing from Palembang before 15th January next, and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention in due course, and advise me immediately the work of demolition has been commenced.
