
I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 15th instant respecting the steamer "SOENGEI GERONG", and note that you have sold this vessel to Shanghai to be broken up, but that you wish to send her with a cargo of white products to Hong Kong prior to her proceeding to Shanghai, and that she will not be sailing from Palembang before 15th January next.

The Committee have had the case before them again today, and having regard to the facts mentioned in your letter, I have to say that in the circumstances they will be prepared to extend the validity of the current classification certificate to cover the proposed voyage.
