S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st instant, and carefully note your remarks regarding the steamer "SOENGEI GERONG".

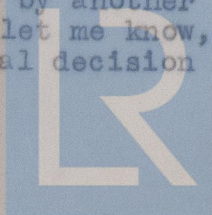
