Dear Mr. Scott,

I return herewith the First Entry Report and midship sections of the S.S. "FERNLEAF".

The thickness of the bulkhead plating is as shown on the approved plan. In view, however, of the variety of thicknesses and of the arrangement of bulkheads of this vessel it was not practicable to indicate every size in the space provided on the report.

The thickness of F. G. & H. strakes is .68. The midship section as built was in error in this respect and has been amended. 20 fathoms of 14" Manilla Spring have been supplied as part of the towline and a note to this effect has been made on the report.
