H. I have to acquaint you that in January last the Society's Surveyor at Rio de Janeiro recommended that permanent repairs should be effected to the deck plating of the steamer "PARDO" on her return to the U.K.

The Society's Surveyors at Liverpool now report that the vessel has been examined with a view to an interim certificate being issued to enable the vessel to proceed to a port in Italy with a cargo of coal to be broken up.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention and advise me immediately the work of demolition is commenced.


