SAN EDUARDO (s).—See London under "Miscellaneous."

London, Dec. 27.—A serious accident occurred yesterday in the stokehold of the oil steamer San Eduardo, built by Messrs. Swan, Hunter and Wigham Richardson, Ltd., at the Neptune Works, Walker, Newcastle. The vessel was being prepared for her trial trip to-day, and 10 men were working in the stokehold, when a great sheet of flame burst from one of the furnaces. The flame filled the narrow compartment and all the men were severely injured.

SAN EDUARDO (s).—South Shields, Dec. 27, 11 47 a.m.—Yesterday sudden outbreak of fire, which died out almost immediately, occurred stokehold new tank steamer San Eduardo, in course completion afloat at Neptune Shipyard at Walker. Several workmen burned, some rather seriously. Damage to ship, if any, unknown.
