Survey

A2ND Special Survey No.3 has been partly held in lieu of 2nd S.S. No.2, due 3.29.

The Owners have furnished the usual undertaking.

On the 8th instant the Owners were informed that it was noted *In view of the intended Sale* that they were in negotiation to sell the vessel to Italian buyers for breaking up, and that in the event of their doing so they desired permission for the vessel to proceed to an Italian port with a cargo of coal and they were informed that the Committee had had the case under consideration and would be agreeable to authorising the Surveyors at Cardiff to issue a certificate for the proposed voyage provided they satisfied themselves that the hull, engines and boilers were efficient for the intended voyage.

The Cardiff Surveyors now report the vessel examined afloat. All holds and tween decks, upper bunkers, engine and boiler spaces, decks, hatches, coamings, ventilators, steering engine and general equipment examined.

In the Surveyors' opinion the vessel is in an efficient condition for a proposed voyage from Cardiff to a port in Italy.

It is submitted action be deferred.
