The Owners were informed on the 26th November that the Committee would be agreeable to this vessel proceeding with a cargo of coal from this country to Italy where she is to be broken up, provided a satisfactory general examination be made afloat.

The Southampton Surveyors now report the vessel generally examined afloat and found in good condition and fit for a voyage from a port in the U.K. to an Italian port with a cargo of coal.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey.
