Messrs. Cantieri Riuniti dell'Adriatico state also that they have bought the steamers "NOVIAN", "NESSIAN", "NAPIERIAN" and "VASSILIOS PANDELIS", No. 32092, 31727, 31615 and 37185 in Register Book respectively and inform us that the demolition of these vessels will be commenced early in 1934.
