This vessel was reported to be laid up at Avonmouth in 8,32, and a letter was recently received from the Owners stating that she had been sold to Italian buyers to proceed to Italy to be broken up. In a further letter they state that the contract stipulates that the permission of this Society must be obtained for the vessel to make a voyage loaded with coal or in ballast under her own steam to an Italian port.

From a previous letter it appears that the vessel made a round trip to the Levant since she was laid up.

As the 2nd S.S.No.3 of this vessel does not become due until 11,34, it is submitted the Bristol Surveyor might be authorised to issue a certificate to enable the vessel to proceed to Italy, with cargo, *from an examination of the vessel* provided he is satisfied that she is in fit condition to do so.
