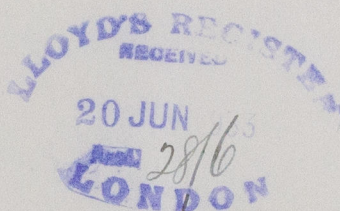

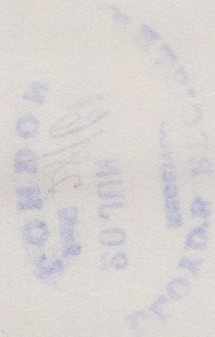
I am, Dear Sir,
