With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "RANGDON MARU", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today a report received from the Society's Surveyors at Calcutta of an examination made of this vessel as far as practicable afloat after grounding.

Soundings were taken and so far as could be seen no damage or leakage appears to have been sustained, but it is recommended that the vessel be examined in dry dock at the first convenient opportunity.

I take this opportunity to remind you that the Second Special Survey No.3, which became due in April last, was partly held at Yokohama in May last.
