With reference to your report No. 11705a on the Steamer "SUNTEMPLE", I have to acquaint you that it would appear that in addition to the items mentioned in the report as remaining to complete the survey for classification in this case, the holds and tween decks require to be examined, the ceiling lifted and the plating in way of side lights examined, but I shall be glad if you will kindly state whether this is so.
