Sir,

We beg to enclose, herewith, machinery Report on Form No.4, regarding the steamer "SUNTEMPLE", the vessel has now left this port for London where it is stated that the survey would be completed.

To complete the survey the electric light installation is to be examined and reported on. Owing to the short time available it was not possible to do this at Southampton.

Further it is the intention of the Owners to fit <sup>AN</sup> oil fuel installation, and to submit the refrigerating machinery appliances for classification.

With regard to the steam pipes it was stated by the Board of Trade, that the main and auxiliary steam pipes were tested by hydrostatic pressure to Board of Trade requirements in October, 1922.

The certificates of tests of Material have been applied for by the Builders and will be forwarded as soon as received.
