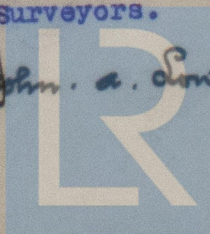
The owners, we understand, are contemplating installing oil fuel burning to this vessel, and to complete the requirements of the First Entry in London, where the vessel has now sailed.
