Précis of particulars of Casualty

This trawler is reported to have sunk after having grounded near Vestmanna on the 3rd April.

A casualty notice was sent to the owner on 29th April, but no reply has yet been received.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

ESKE.—Reykjavik, Apr. 3.—British steam trawler Eske foundered after having grounded near Vestmanna. Crew landed.

ESKE.—London, Apr. 16.—Hull trawler Eske struck Skerries Rocks, lat. 63° 20' N, long. 20° 24' W, on Apr. 3. The vessel made water rapidly and was soon awash. The crew took to the boat and the Eske sank.
