I am in receipt of Mr. Shute's letter of the 7th (? 5th) instant respecting the new steamer "SOUTHERN", Messrs. W. Dobson & Co's No. 192, and may say that his remarks have been duly noted.

In reply thereto I am directed to state that if the cargo battens in the shelter 'tween decks are omitted the endorsement on the certificate and the notation in the Register Book will be "Cargo battens not fitted in the shelter 'tween decks".
