Dear Mr. Middleton,

I notice from the Newcastle Rtn. 5c of the 18th instant respecting the steamer "BERNHARD BLUMENFELD" that attention has been called to the Boiler Survey of this vessel, and I thought I would just point out to you that this survey will not become due until the end of August next, i.e. six years from the date of build.

At the same time I should like to ask how the matter of the Boiler Survey of the steamer "HIGHLAND WATCH" stands. In your memorandum of the 12th instant you state that this survey is proceeding". Does this mean that it will be completed shortly, or whether it will take a long time in view of your statement that the vessel is lying up indefinitely?
