Dear Sir,

R. I have to acquaint you that the steamer "HEREFORDSHIRE" which is at present lying at Dartmouth, has been sold to Messrs. Douglas & Ramsey, of Glasgow, and it is stated that she will probably be towed to the Clyde to be broken up. In any event the new Owners do not intend to have any portion of the vessel or her boilers surveyed before she is brought round.

In the circumstances, the case has been submitted to the Committee, who have decided to make a record of "To be broken up" against her name in the Register Book, and to expunge the vessel's classification in accordance with the usual practice.
