Dear Sir,

In compliance with the request contained in your letter of the 15th instant I enclose herewith the classification certificates for the hull, engines and boiler of the steam trawler "SAINT SIMON" ex "LOCH NEVIS".

In connexion with this case it is observed that the marks for the 1st bower anchor and the kedge anchor are not decipherable, and no weights are given.

It is concluded, however, in view of the figure "1" having been assigned that the Surveyors have satisfied themselves that these anchors are satisfactory, but at the same time I am directed to say that it is considered that their weights should at least have been obtained, or arrangements made to have them weighed. If it is at all possible this should be done and particulars of the weights forwarded.
