Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that in April last the Society's Surveyor at Istanbul reported that the steamer "DIMITRIOS L. DANILOLOS" had sustained damage through collision, subsequent beaching and salvage operations. Temporary repairs were effected and the Surveyor recommended that the steamer should be further examined and permanently repaired at Antwerp.

The Antwerp Surveyors now state that the Owners and the Underwriters have arranged for the vessel to be broken up, and to enable her to proceed to Italy with a cargo of coal some further repairs have been carried out.

The vessel is to proceed via Rotterdam to Civita-Vecchia with a cargo of coal and thence in ballast to Genoa or Savona to be broken up, and I shall be glad if you will advise me immediately the work of demolition is commenced.


