With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "WHEATPLAIN", I beg to acquaint you that on the occasion of the recent survey of the vessel by the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool, the donkey boiler tubes were found to be badly wasted, and it was stated that the tubes would be renewed at the first opportunity, but in the meantime the donkey boiler would not be used.

In the circumstances I am directed to say that the Committee have continued the classification of the steamer subject to the donkey boiler not being used again until it has been repaired and satisfactorily reported upon by the Society's Surveyors.
