


S.S. "CACIQUE".

This vessel was built in 1910 by Messrs. Short Bros. (Yard No. being 358) Damage has occurred on separate occasions to the Tween Deck, in way of the hatchways, the hatchway coamings and decks having sagged and the pillars buckled.

The approved plan of Quarter Pillars and Girders is not sufficiently definite to permit of reinforcement being ~~made to~~ <sup>designed for</sup> the girders in way of the hatchways in a satisfactory manner, since alternative designs for the deep girders under the deck are indicated thereon.

It is submitted this plan be forwarded to the Sunderland Surveyors, who should be requested to confer with the Builders and indicate on the sketch which scantlings have been adopted and actually fitted in the vessel.
