With reference to your letter of the 17th ultimo regarding the case of the steamer "CACIQUE", I have to acquaint you that on this vessel's recent arrival here the Owners stated that they were unable to carry out at this time the repairs recommended by the Newport News Surveyors in February last, and asked that the matter be allowed to stand over until the steamers return from a voyage to Archangel. The Surveyors at Newport News were communicated with and their reply is attached, from which it will be seen that, in their opinion, the necessary permanent repairs may be postponed for another voyage.

The Owners have been informed that it is noted the Newport News Surveyors' recommendation will be carried out on the vessel's return.
