I have to acquaint you that in February last, the Society's Surveyors at Newport News (Newport News Report No. 1104) reported that the Steamer "CACIQUE" had been surveyed on account of damage, and they recommended that the main and lower deck beams, girders, tie bars, and hatch coamings should be repaired on the Vessel's return to the United States. also that a bower anchor and 30 fathoms of chain cable stated to have been lost, and since recovered should be placed on board at the earliest opportunity. I shall therefore be glad if you will ascertain and let me know what further arrangements have been made for these matters to be attended to.
