DAMAGE ATTRIBUTED TO FIRE IN NO 3 HOLD:-

Paint on after bulkhead and tunnel burned and lower hold soiled by smoke and fire.

Bilges half full of water and nitrate.

Ceiling burned locally.

Repairs now effected:-

Bilges to be cleaned and cement washed.
