With further reference to your letter of the 22nd July last I have to inform you that calculations have now been made to determine the stresses brought upon the beams in the tween decks of the S.S. "CACIQUE" resulting in the damage which you reported to me in your letter.

These calculations go to show that the damage in question was due to the improper concentration of the nitrate cargo in the tween decks at the part of the deck which came down instead of the nitrate cargo being distributed uniformly as it should have been.
