I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant regarding the case of the S.S. "CACIQUE", and in reply to the enquiry contained therein, the Captain informed me that the weight of the cargo carried in the lower 'tween deck space in way of No.3 hatchway was 586 tons, comprised of nitrate of soda in bags, each bag weighs about 210 lbs., and stows at about 30 cubic feet to the ton.
