

Your inquiry with reference to the above vessel which stranded at Guion Island, Cape Breton, is received and in reply thereto because of bad weather and ice conditions it has not been possible for the representatives of the Underwriters to make a thorough and complete examination of the vessel but there is evidence of very serious damage, so much so that it would appear that the Underwriters are not able to arrange for salvage on a "no cure, no pay" basis and we are anticipating that within a comparatively short time we may learn that the Underwriters have decided to abandon the vessel as a total loss.
