The 3rd S.S. No.1, due 4,31, has been partly held and to complete same all the Rule requirements remain to be complied with except the examination of the bottom and rudder in dry dock, internal examination of fore and after peak tanks, Nos. 1 & 7, both sides, and No. 5, starboard side, double bottom tanks, examination of pumps and watertight doors and the ranging of the cables.

The vessel being laid up the Owners have furnished an undertaking.

In a letter dated the 25th ultimo forwarded by the Kobe Surveyors the Owners write to the effect that the vessel is still laid up.

The year of grace expired 4,32.

It is submitted for consideration whether in view of the Special Survey being now more than two years overdue, the Kobe Surveyors should be requested to arrange with the Owners for the vessel to be generally examined.
