LLOYD'S SURVEY.

When at your Works in December the Signer mentioned to Lloyd's Surveyor that the hull of the dredger would be re-erected and the machinery installed under Lloyd's survey at Rangoon, and we understood that the Glasgow Surveyor would send a report to the Rangoon Surveyor.
