Maschinenfabrik Augsburg-Nürnberg A.G. attend at their works at Augsburg on various dates for the purpose of surveying during construction one starting air receiver of 1100 ltr. capacity to the order of Messrs. Wm. Simons & Co. of Renfrew and destined for their yard No. 704.

This starting air receiver has been surveyed during construction by the undersigned. The materials have been tested by the Society's Surveyors and the scantlings are in accordance to the approved plan M17807 and instructions thereto.

The starting air receiver has been riveted and the workmanship thereon is satisfactory.

The starting air receiver has been submitted to internal hydraulic pressure of 45 atm. in my presence, showed no signs of weakness and was found tight and sound in every respect at this pressure.

Working pressure not to exceed 30 atm.
