The Surveyor should be informed that his recommendations in respect to any renewal or doubling of any individual plates found to be unduly wasted, may (provided the surfaces of the plating are in good condition) take account of the thickness of shell plating required by the present Rules, as well as the original thickness.

The Surveyor should be requested to return the sheet when forwarding his report.
