S.S. "MOUNT ATHOS".

Proposal to instal second hand Donkey Boiler.

The Rotterdam Surveyors state that the Owners wish to instal in this vessel a donkey boiler which was removed from the s.s. "ROI LEOPOLD". It is stated that the boiler was constructed under the survey of the British Corporation, and the Surveyors forward a plan of boiler for consideration.

The scantlings of the boiler as shown on the plan meet the requirements of the Rules for a working pressure of 90 lb. per sq. inch.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Rotterdam Surveyors be informed that the scantlings of the boiler as shown on the plan meet the requirements of the Rules for a working pressure of 90 lb. per sq. inch, and no exception will be taken to the proposal to instal this boiler in the above vessel, provided the boiler be examined and be found or placed in good condition, the scantlings be in accordance with the approved plan, and the boiler be found sound and tight under hydraulic test.

The Surveyors should be requested to ascertain whether it can be definitely established that this boiler was constructed under survey of the British Corporation.
