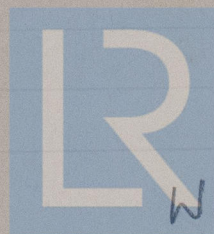
It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed, with record of Survey 3.31 and notation of S.S. H.Kg No 2-31 as recommended.
