Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 7th instant respecting the S.S. "CAXIAS", and with regard thereto I shall be glad if you will be good enough to forward particulars of the scantlings of the upper bridge deck, which from the sketch of midship section appears to be a structural part of the vessel's topsides, and from the profile plan to extend practically the whole length of the bridge.

It is also not quite clear whether all the eight watertight bulkheads reported extend to the upper deck or whether some of them extend to the second deck only, and I shall be pleased to hear from you on the subject.
