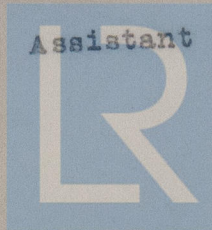
Sent:- "RUY BARBOSA Classed 100A1 with Freeboard stop certificates sent you 14th instant".
