This ex-German Steamer was built at Vegesack in 1913
classified with the Germanischer Lloyd.

Plans of midship section and profile, together
with a First Entry Report and report of a survey held for
classification were submitted by the Hamburg Surveyors who
were informed in July last that the vessel could be recommended
for the class 100A- With Freeboard, and provided the marks on
the anchors and chain cables be compared and verified with
those shewn on the test certificates the vessel could also be
recommended for the figure 1 for equipment.

The same Surveyors now report the vessel placed
dry dock and the bottom cleaned and coated.

The equipment of anchors and chain cables has
been verified with the certificates of test and found in
order.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be
classified 100A1 (Steel) With freeboard, with record of survey
No. 24 and notation of s.s. Ham. No. 3-4, 23. The summer freeboard of
6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from centre of disc to top of statutory deck line
upper deck, now marked on the vessel's sides, to be inserted
in the classification certificate and recorded in the Register
Book, and further, the remaining freeboards, as shewn on the
accompanying verification form, to be inserted in the certificate
of classification.
