With further reference to our recent interviews with your Mr. Butler and Mr. Fred Harwood; owing to the fact that the French "Acte de Francisation" shows the vessel as having been built 1913, we are unable at the moment to obtain the sanction of the Greek Government to her transfer, boats over twenty years being refused permission to be transferred to the Greek nationality.

In an effort to get the French Nationality papers corrected in accordance with actual fact, we shall be glad if as requested you will kindly let us have letter addressed to Societe Generale de Transports Maritimes a Vapeur, 70, Rue de la Republique, Marseilles, confirming the information you were good enough to give us verbally last week regarding the date of your first visit, date of issue of Interim Certificate and also date of your last visit prior to actual Lloyd's Classification being granted.

With this information in their possession, plus confirmation from builders (which is actually in our possession) that vessel was not completed until 1914, we are hopeful that the necessary adjustment can be made to enable the transaction to be completed.
