"SUPPLIED NOW OR EARLIEST POSSIBLE DATE TO AVOID
"FURTHER DETENTION MR. BUCHANAN HAS LETTER FROM
"PRINCIPAL SURVEYOR GIVING SOME PARTICULARS".

"CERTIFICATES TONIGHT INSTRUCTING ODESSA SURVEYOR
"ISSUE PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE AS DESIRED".
