
Nature of Survey _____

The Marseilles Surveyors report this vessel generally examined (at the Owners' request) afloat/with a view to preparing an estimate for carrying out the 2nd S.S. No.2 which becomes due in 3,34.

The Owners were informed that part of the chain cables might require to be renewed when they are properly ranged for Special Survey.

It is stated that provided the estimated cost was not too high it is proposed to fit the vessel with an oil fuel burning installation and that plans of this arrangement will be submitted for the Committee's approval should it be decided to proceed with the work.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey.
