A proposal to carry out the above survey within the year of grace was agreed to in August last.

At the beginning of April last the Owners wrote that the vessel was laid up in the Tyne pending a decision in regard to the Special Survey, and in the circumstances the Committee deferred action in the matter for a short time.

On the 11th April the Owners wrote that no decision had been made in the matter but that she would not be recommissioned without having the Special Survey held.

In reply the Owners were informed that if the vessel was laid up indefinitely the usual form of undertaking would be






