The 2nd S.S. No.2 became due 3,33 and the Owners' proposal to carry out same within the year of grace has been agreed to.

The port hawsepipe required to be renewed.

The London Surveyors now report the vessel examined afloat after grounding and no leakage found.

It is stated that upon making enquiries about the port hawsepipe it was claimed by the Master of the vessel to have been renewed. The hawsepipe was examined and found satisfactory.

The Surveyors recommend the vessel be specially examined in dry dock at the Owners' convenience.

It is submitted action be deferred and the Owners advised of the Surveyors' recommendation.
