Dear Sirs,

With reference to the casualty which is reported to  
have occurred in the case of the above-named vessel, I beg  
to acquaint you that, in accordance with the usual practice,  
the question of inserting a record of the circumstances  
against the vessel's name in the Register Book will come  
under the Committee's consideration at an early meeting. In  
the event of such a record being made, the vessel's character  
would--as is the ordinary course in such cases--be expunged  
from the Register Book at the same time.

If, however, you are aware of any circumstances which  
may render it desirable that the Committee should defer  
taking the steps above described, I shall be glad if you  
will kindly communicate with me by return of post.
