S.S. "LA CRESCENTA".

We are in receipt of your letter of the 8th inst., for which we thank you.

The above vessel left Port San Luis on the 24th November 1934 bound for Osaka, and was in communication with other vessels up to 12.05 a.m. G.M.T. on December 6th, Lat. 34.51 N. Long. 163.24 W. Repeated calls after the above time failed to elicit a response, and on January 6th 1935 the s.s. "ATHELBEACH" reported passing through large pools of oil on the surface of the sea in the Pacific Lat. 35 N. Long. 164 W.

In view of the above facts, we are compelled with much regret to conclude that the vessel foundered in the storm of December 6th 1934, and has now been posted at Lloyds as missing.

In view of this fact, we have no objection to the vessel's character being expunged from the Register Book.
