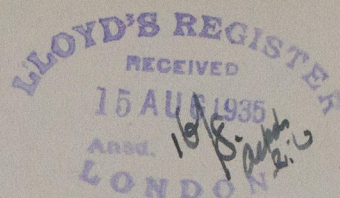

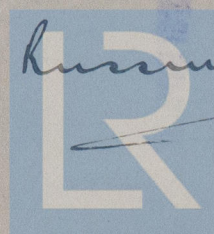
S.S. "LA CRESCENTA".


