The Board of Trade Authorities who are holding an enquiry into the loss of this vessel in the Pacific last December are asking for the latest Freeboard Certificate or copy of same.

The Captain informed us that when the vessel was at Yokohama from October 17 to 23rd, 1934, Lloyd's Surveyor, when on board in connection with the Annual Boiler Survey, verified the freeboard markings and his fee in respect to this inspection was paid by our agents at Yokohama.

If a new Certificate was issued on that occasion, it would have been on board when the vessel was lost, so we shall feel obliged if you will let us have some documentary evidence shewing that the freeboard markings were in order last October which we can hand to the Board of Trade Authorities.
